

#### **NOMINATION PAPERS**

### **OVERVIEW**

Members of the Rocky Mountain Métis Association (RMMA) interested in serving on the Board of Directors are invited to submit their nomination papers. The following outlines the required steps and documentation for submitting a nomination, as well as guidelines for nominations made from the floor during the Annual General Meeting (AGM).

### NOMINATION PROCESS

- Availability of Nomination Papers

  Members may obtain nomination forms from a current Board of Directors member, from the RMMA website, or from the RMMA Community Navigator in the RMMA Community Space at least fourteen (14) days before the AGM.
- Floor Nominations: Members may also be nominated from the floor during the AGM.

# REQUIRED DOCUMENTENTS FOR NOMINATION

Candidates seeking a position on the Board must provide the following:

1. Nomination Form

A document that identifies the individual making the nomination and the candidate accepting it.

2. Proof of Residency

A document that demonstrates the nominee's current residency within the community (BC Government issued I.D. that includes current residential address).

3. Proof of MNBC Citizenship

A valid Métis Nation British Columbia (MNBC) citizenship card or equivalent documentation verifying MNBC citizenship.

4. Signed Attestation of Eligibility

Each nominee must submit a signed Attestation of Eligibility. This attestation confirms that the nominee meets all eligibility criteria to serve on the Board of Directors and complies with Section 44 of the British Columbia Societies Act.

# **SUBMISSION**

All completed nomination papers, including the signed Nomination Form, Proof of Residency, Proof of MNBC Citizenship, and the signed Attestation of Eligibility, must be submitted to the Nomination Committee at least 3 days prior to the date of the AGM or brought to the AGM for floor nominations.

\*Without these documents, a nominee may be disqualified from standing for election.
